

**GEFA YEAR 21 - CONTRACT II – WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**  
**January 2010**

**Project Description:** This is a 2009 project, financed through a loan from Georgia Environmental Facilities Authority (GEFA) to provide Water Main Improvements. Additional funding for Engineering Design, Project Management and other project costs is from Public Utilities Capital Projects Fund. This project will replace old 2"-galvanized water lines, extend new water service to residents in the Gainesville/Hall County community, and improve fire and water service by installing fire hydrants in new locations and updating and improving flow capacity and quality in the water distribution system.

**Project Status:** The project is nearing 70% completion and the contractor has, to date, installed 1,307 linear feet (LF) of 8" DIP, 18,708 LF of 6" DIP and 9709 LF of 2" PVC main. A number of roads were recently added to the project, including water extensions on Jewell Circle and Bert Drive and the replacement of a 2" galvanized line on Candlestick Lane. Contractor is due additional time for work added to the project.
