Amend Chapter 3-4 entitled Motor Vehicles and Traffic as it Pertains to Speed Laws Applicable

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE GEORGIA UNIFORM RULES OF THE ROAD, SECTIONS 40-6-181, 40-6-184, 40-6-185, AND 40-6-188 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED TO REGULATE TRAFFIC UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE; TO AMEND SECTION 3-4-61 ENTITLED "SPEED LAWS APPLICABLE" BY ELIMINATING IT IN ITS ENTIRETY AND SUBSTITUTING IN ITS PLACE THE LANGUAGE SET FORTH BELOW; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR CODIFICATION; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
