



3rd Annual Water Conservation Calendar Contest



Know a student artist between Kindergarten and 12th grade? If so, have them enter our annual calendar contest! All students attending Hall County Schools, Gainesville City Schools, or any private or home school within the City of Gainesville water service area is eligible.

The contest theme is:

Stormwater— Where it Goes & Pollution Solutions



Deadline for the contest is Thursday, October 1, 2020.

Who May Enter: All Kindergarten through 12th grade students that attend Hall County Schools, Gainesville City Schools, or any private or home school within the City of Gainesville water service area is eligible.

Instructions: All entries must be postmarked by October 1, 2020 to be eligible. Entries may be created with pen, colored pencils, acrylic or poster paints, watercolors, crayons, or colored markers. All words must be printed neatly in large dark print.

Artwork must be submitted on an 8 1/2" X 11" white poster board or paper and drawn in landscape orientation (11" side horizontal). Only original artwork will be accepted. Entries must be mailed or brought to the City of Gainesville Water Resources office during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 8am-5pm). No entries will be accepted without a completed entry form.

Only one entry per student/artist. Water Resources is not responsible for lost, stolen, illegible, or misdirected entries. Entries cannot be returned. All entries become the property of Water Resources and may be used in other promotions without further permission or compensation to the artist.

Judging criteria includes, but is not limited to: Best expression of theme, picture design, creativity, and artistic skill. Winners will be notified by November 1, 2020. The selected entries will be displayed in the 2021 Water Conservation Calendar. The artists of entries selected for full-page display in the calendar will be honored on the Water Resources Facebook page and have their artwork displayed as a downloadable calendar on the City of Gainesville Water Resource webpage. We will choose 13 posters to use for our 2021 Water Conservation Calendar. Winners will also receive a prize pack.
