### ALL NON-WAXED PAPER

- NEWSPAPER
- BOXES
- BOOKS (HARD OR SOFTBACK)



### BOX #1

## METAL

### ALUMINUM AND TIN CANS, SCRAP METAL AND CLEAN FOIL

- EMPTY AND RINSE ALL FOOD AND LIQUID ITEMS
- NO POTS AND PANS



### BOX #2

## PLASTIC

### #1 & #2 BOTTLES AND JUGS

- EMPTY AND RINSE ALL FOOD AND LIQUID ITEMS



### BOX #3

ALL OTHER RECYCLABLES MUST GO TO THE HALL COUNTY RECYCLING CENTER OR 12 COMPACTOR SITES:

- GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES (Empty all food and liquid.)
- MOTOR OIL / BRAKE FLUID / HYDRAULIC OIL
- PALLETS (48 X 40 wood pallets only)
- CLOTHING
- ELECTRONICS (No tube type TVs)
- COOKING GREASE (Recycling Center only)


